<b>Titel of excursion</b>	Peatland research and nature conservation near Anklam (near Island of Usedom), establishing a new reed stand, rewetting for breeding birds
<b>Max number of participants</b>	45
<b>Cost of excursion</b>	€75
<b>Time of departure from Greifswald</b>	08:30
<b>Estimated arrival back in Greifswald</b>	17:00
<b>Catering</b>	Small packed breakfast and packed lunch. Drinks and cake.
<b>Toilet facilities</b>	Toilet break at aprox. 13:00
<b>Clothing recommendation</b>	Comfortable boots for walking on dirt roads (10 km in total), weather protection
<b>Excursion description</b>	Lower Peene river valley near Anklam with large rewetted sites; long-term project “peatland pilot” with 480 ha former grassland currently in rewetting process; establishment of new reed stand on 40 ha, broad monitoring activities, such as for mosquitos, biodiversity and GHG emissions; project sites of LIFE “LIMICODRA” with high water levels for the protection of meadow birds.
<b>Rough itinerary for the trip</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Bargischoh Visit the project site (former grassland in rewetting process) with introduction to project, aims &amp; challenges, Eddy tower, new reed cultivation site (rd. 2:00 h)</li><li>2. Ferne Wiesen – site facts to reed harvesting area and introduction to mosquito investigation project (rd. 1:30 h)</li><li>3. Lunchbreak during bus transfer, toilet break at Life Limicodra project office in Rosenhagen (30 +15 min)</li><li>4. Rosenhagen – visit of rewetted Anklamer Stadtbruch and introduction to EU Life project for waders/meadow birds (rd. 2:30 h)</li></ol>
